Thirteenth Sunday In Ordinary Time



The Prophet Ezekiel, Saint Paul and the Lord Jesus share something in common in today's scripture readings. They all experience obstacles to their ministry. Ezekiel is summoned to prophesy to the Israelites, who are "Hardened of face and obstinate of heart" Ezekiel 2:4). Saint Paul recounts how he has been given a "thorn in the flesh" 2 Corinthians (12:7) The Lord Jesus is unable to perform many signs in his native place. The Gospel tells us that "He was amazed at their lack of faith"(Mark 6:6). We too sometimes encounter obstacles as we travel along the journey of faith. So often we experience weakness on this journey. Let the words of the Lord to St. Paul encourage us today: "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness" 2 Corinthians 12:9).
